Practice and memorize the words below using the sentence clues, drawings, patterns, and hints provided to prepare you for a FRIDAY word journey quiz during Literacy Block. Be mindful of capitalization - use capital letters only for proper nouns. If you write using all caps make sure it looks like the all caps below.

1. **CASUALTIES** is spelled like the two words **casual** and **ties**.
2. **CATEGORY** is in a **category** all by itself because it begins **cate-**, not **cata-**. Think of the word having a big **ego** in the middle because it is not like **catacomb**, **cataclysm**, and **catatonic**. Draw **category**...
3. **CEMETERY**. Strangely enough, **cemetery** has a **meter** in the middle of it. Draw **cemetery**...

4. **CHASTISE** ends **-se**, not **-ze**. Remember that **chastise** is another word for scold.

5. **CHOOSE** is present tense, when you select now. Drag out your choice with the two o's.

7. A **CHORD** is a combination of notes played in harmony. Remember the **h** that begins harmony.
